COVID Summary

In 2020-2021 school year, HASD remained in-person for the duration of the year with only a few periods of virtual learning. The High School delivered virtual education only 40 school days, 9 of which were due to snow and inclement weather. HASD was one of the few districts in the state that maintained in-person learning from the start of school in August 2020.

We are the Hamburg Hawks. Located in northern Berks County, the Hamburg Area School District covers 103 square miles and is the largest, geographically, of the county's 18 public school districts.

The District encompasses three boroughs (Hamburg, Strausstown, and Shoemakersville) and five townships (Perry, Windsor, Tilden, Upper Bern, and Upper Tulpehocken).

Interstate 78, from Harrisburg to Allentown, passes through the area and intersects with PA Route 61 connecting Pottsville and Reading. Philadelphia is 80 miles to the south; Harrisburg is 55 miles to the west.
