Volunteer Affirmation

A Hamburg Area School District volunteer who has been a resident of Pennsylvania (PA) during the entirety of the previous ten-year period does not need to submit a Report of Federal Criminal History Record (fingerprinting) if this Volunteer Affirmation is completed.

I, (print name) _____, would like to serve in the position of an unpaid volunteer for the Hamburg Area School District. Under penalty of law, I affirm that I have been a PA resident during the entirety of the ten-year period prior to my signing this Volunteer Affirmation. I am aware that the Hamburg Area School District will be relying upon this Volunteer Affirmation for the purpose of complying with PA’s Child Protective Services Law (“CPSL”). I further affirm that I am not disqualified from service as a school volunteer by reason of having been convicted of any of the following offenses under Title 18 of the PA Crimes Code or of an offense similar in nature under the laws or former laws of the United States of one of its territories or possessions, another state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or a foreign nation, or under a former law of PA:

- Chapter 25 (relating to criminal homicide)
- Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault)
- Section 2709.1 (relating to stalking)
- Section 2901 (relating to kidnapping)
- Section 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint)
- Section 3121 (relating to rape)
- Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory and sexual assault)
- Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual intercourse)
- Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault)
- Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault)
- Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault)
- Section 3127 (relating to indecent exposure)
- Section 4302 (relating to incest)
- Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of child)
- Section 4304 (relating to endangering the welfare of children)
- Section 4305 (relating to dealing with infant children)
- A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses)
- Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances)
- Section 6301 (relating to corruption of minors)
- Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children)
- A felony offense under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device, and Cosmetic Act, committed within the five-year period immediately preceding today’s date.
- The attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to commit any of the above offenses.

I hereby affirm that the information contained in the Volunteer Affirmation is correct. I further affirm that in the event that I am arrested for or convicted of an offense that would constitute grounds for denying my further participation as a school volunteer, or if I am named as a perpetrator of child abuse, I will provide the Hamburg Area School District with written notice not later than 72 hours after the arrest, conviction, or notification that I have been listed as a perpetrator of child abuse in the statewide database.
