IN CASE OF WORK-RELATED INJURY

- If you suffer a compensable work-related injury, your employer or its insurance company must pay for reasonable surgical and medical services and supplies, orthopedic appliances and prostheses, including training in their use.
- In order to ensure that your medical treatment will be paid for by your employer or the insurance company, you must immediately advise your supervisor of your injury, and be treated by one of the licensed physicians or medical providers listed below:

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- If you need treatment, you must continue to visit one of the medical providers listed above for ninety (90) days from the date of your first visit. You may during this ninety (90) day period switch from one of the designated providers to another. If you obtain treatment from a provider who is not on this list, your employer may not be required to pay these services.
- After this ninety (90) day period, if you still need treatment and your employer had provided a list as set forth above, you may
 choose to go to another licensed physician or medical provider for reasonable and necessary treatment. You must notify your
 employer of this action within five (5) days of your visit to the provider of your choice, or your employer may not be required to pay
 for these services.
- Your bills will be paid for IF: your licensed physician or medical provider files reports as required. (These reports must be filed within ten (10) days after your first visit and at least once a month thereafter for as long as treatment continues.)
- In the event a posted panel physician recommends invasive surgery, you may seek a second opinion with a physician of your choice. If you choose to undergo the invasive surgery, you must use a designated physician for the treatment for ninety (90) days from the date of the first visit to the additional provider.
- If no list is provided as above, you may go to a licensed physician or medical provider of your choice.
- If one of the providers listed above refers you to another licensed specialist, your employer or his insurer will pay the bill for these services related to your compensable condition.
- If you are faced with a medical emergency, you may secure assistance from a hospital or physician of your choice but subsequent non-emergency treatment shall be provided by a designated provider for the remainder of the ninety (90) day period.

REMEMBER, IT IS IMPORTANT TO TELL YOUR EMPLOYER ABOUT YOUR INJURY IMMEDIATELY
