Hamburg's Student Assistance Program offers a wide variety of support groups to help students learn to cope effectively with many common barriers to their educational success. These curriculum-based and skill-building groups allow students to gain strength and understanding in a confidential setting from peers and provides them with the tools necessary to thrive despite challenges. Groups typically last for 45 minutes in duration, once a week, for about eight weeks. The groups are facilitated by a Student Assistance Program Specialist from Caron Treatment Centers. Groups will be conducted either inperson or remotely via video or audio-conferencing technology or a combination of both.
